How cancer changed everything.



"I'm a wife and mother to two beautiful children. My life was really good. I had always been a healthy person but that changed at the age of 45 <u>when I was diagnosed with cancer</u>.

I needed a colonoscopy. As I was coming around from the anaesthesia my husband and I were told the news... I had cancer... stage 3 bowel cancer.

I was shocked. I wondered how could this happen to me. I'd never been sick.

I was referred to Austin Health and the ONJ Cancer Centre. <u>When I came to the Centre</u> <u>I met with a ligison nurse who took me through</u> <u>everything that would happen</u>.

For six weeks I underwent intensive radiation and chemotherapy. Once the cancer shrank Dr Philip Smart performed surgery to remove it. One of the really frightening moments was being told I would need to wear a colostomy bag forever. However, six months later Dr Smart performed wonderful re-constructive surgery.

Two and a half years later, I am cancer free.

It was a scary time, however the staff at the ONJ Centre were amazing, providing worldclass care and support in a beautiful setting."





Of hope and determination.



"In May 2015 I woke up with a sore back. I was never sick, I was fit, health conscious and ate really well. However, for a week and a half I felt like I had a chill. Eventually I went to the doctor who ran blood and urine tests and then said I needed to see a haematologist.

When you are referred to a specialist you expect to be told what the issue is <u>But you never expect to be told you</u> have Myeloma. <u>It's one of the toughest</u> cancers to beat but I am determined.

Everything happened so fast. The staff talked gently, diplomatically and beautifully, giving me confidence to begin the treatment. They guided me as I prepared for an autograft procedure, a stem cell procedure where cells are treated and stored, ready to be transplanted back into me at a later date.

When I was at the ONJ Centre I met Olivia Newton-John. I told her that everyone who walked into my room were encouraging, supportive and understanding. Even though I was petrified, everyone at the ONJ were amazing They gave me hope."

"We are very fortunate to have many different types of opportunities for patients to access treatment at the ONJ Cancer Centre. We have world leaders, a thriving clinical trial program and close connections between research and bedside care.

I work in a field with ready access to new ideas. Sometimes these new ideas are 'difference makers' for patients.

Research into blood cancer has moved forward incredibly quickly with each passing year, and sustainable funding is critical to that research happening.

For patients like Suzi both <u>research and</u> <u>care are integrally important</u>. She has a number of supports within her treating team. Suzi has a specialist haematologist, a team of doctors, nurse coordinators and a veritable army of nurses to help her through the complicated areas of Myeloma treatment, stem cell collection and bone marrow transplantation.

Without kind and caring people who can give, we would have little chance of being able to support the people and the resources who are on the front line of research and wellness."
